Snowmobile Registration

Maine residents may renew a snowmobile registration online. New registrations must be done through a registration agent or the MDIFW main office in Augusta. Nonresidents may register or renew a snowmobile registration online.

What are the fees?

Snowmobile Registration Fees

- \$46 (Resident)
- \$50 (Non Resident 3 Day Registration)
- \$76 (Non Resident 10 Day Registration)
- \$100 (Non Resident Full Season)

The State of Maine allows you to register your snowmobile with the State of Maine. Following your transaction, you will receive a confirmation page to print for immediate use. Your official registration and stickers will arrive at the shipping address specified within thirty days. Registrations may also be obtained from licensing agents or by mail.
